Deadline for submission is **FRIDAY, MARCH 1, 2019**.

1. Fill in the blanks of the change form. If necessary, use additional 8 ½ x 11-inch sheet(s).
2. All submittals must be typed. Please use a 12-point font size. NSPC assumes no responsibility for unclear or illegible submittals.
3. Submittals sent via fax will NOT be accepted.
4. Changes may be submitted electronically in word processor format via e-mail to nspc@iapmo.org prior to the deadline date (see form).
5. To submit proposed changes, please use a separate form for each section. If you are proposing a new chapter or appendix, it should be submitted in its entirety, rather than each section separately.
6. If the proposed change conflicts with or changes other sections, please submit separate changes for all sections so affected. For example, if a code change affects a definition, the change to the definition shall be submitted on a separate Proposed Code Change Form.
7. Your proposed change must be based on the latest edition and must also reflect the actions of the most recent changes to the NSPC.
8. Please submit the code section or subsection to be revised in its entirety. Do not leave out unchanged paragraphs. Strike through all wording to be ~~deleted~~. Underscore all wording to be added.

THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENT IS SUBMITTED: NSPC Section 12.10.5
